THE WORLD MACCABIAH GAMES

The World Maccabiah Games, which are held every four years in the summer following an Olympic year, pits Jewish athletes from all over the world in competition similar to that of the Olympic Games.

It is estimated that over 4,000 Jewish athletes will compete in 30 different sports at the 12th Maccabiah Games scheduled to open at Ramat Gan Stadium on July 15th, making this event the third largest international competition. The United States team which will consist of approximately 550 people, will comprise the second largest contingent at this event, only outnumbered by the host team, Israel. New entries this time will be from Bermuda, Gibraltar, and Monaco, while two new sports, rugby football and high diving, will be included for the first time. Non-Olympic events included in the Games are cricket, badminton, field hockey, squash and golf. Unfortunately, synchronized swimming has been deleted from the program because of insufficient non-American entries. Because of a lack of interest, and too few entries, boxing was suspended four years ago.

In a surprise move, the International Maccabiah Games Committee broke a 53 year-old tradition by approving a resolution that called for the elimination of the impressive national flag display. Michael Kevahazi, committee chairman, indicated, rightly or wrongly, that the action was taken in order to accentuate the fact that the Games symbolize the unity of the Jewish people.
